Chicago - (*Jan, 05 2017*) – Reports to the Chicago and Northern Illinois Better Business Bureau Scam Tracker almost identically match those being reported nationally. In 2016 <u>BBB Scam Tracker</u> confirmed that tax scams still are at the top of the list, despite a <u>huge drop in reports</u> after a September police raid in Mumbai, India.

While the raids have had a huge impact on the reduction of fake IRS calls, the BBB will keep close watch for any resurgence with a new tax season soon approaching.

Dennis Horton, director of the Rockford Regional Office of the Better Business Bureau says, "These scams continue because they are successful enough to make it worthwhile for these thieves to keep trying to con people out of money. There is a science to scams, and it may surprise you to know that scammers use many of the same techniques as legitimate sales professionals. The difference, of course, is that their pitch could cost you a fortune."

The top three scams on the 2016 list – tax scams, debt collection scams, and sweepstakes/prizes/gifts scams – were the same as in 2015. New to the top ten are online purchase scams (#4) and phishing scams (#10). Online purchase scams were common in 2015 as well, but this scam type was not added as a BBB Scam Tracker category until 2016. Employment scams (#5) are also new to the top ten, but only because work-from-home scams, previously a separate category, were included. Another change was the drop of tech support scams from #4 last year to #7 this year.

The list was compiled based on more than 30,000 scam reports filed by consumers on <u>bbb.org/scamtracker</u>, a free interactive online tool launched last year by the BBB Institute for Marketplace Trust. Not all of those consumers lost money, as many recognized the scam before being victimized but reported it anyway to help warn others.
